



## **2012 LEGISLATIVE CONFERENCE NOTICE**

Arrangements for the **2012 Kansas Joint Law Enforcement Legislative Conference** have been completed. Again this year, the **Kansas Association of Chiefs of Police** will meet jointly with the Kansas Sheriffs' Association, and the Kansas Peace Officers' Association to identify and discuss important law enforcement related legislative issues.

The Joint Law Enforcement Legislative Conference will be held **in Topeka** on Wednesday, **January 25th** at the **Ramada Hotel Downtown** (420 SE 6<sup>th</sup> Ave.). **Please make your hotel reservation immediately while rooms are available and to get the special \$ 84 room rate** (plus 14.95% tax). The Legislative Committees of each of the Associations will meet separately to determine their respective positions on various legislative issues. There will then be a Joint Meeting of the Associations to identify major issues and those issues having common support. An evening reception will be hosted for the Legislators during which time members of the Associations will have the opportunity to discuss priority issues with their legislators.
