## THE KANSAS POLICE ADMINISTRATORS SEMINAR

The Kansas Police Administrators Seminar (KPAS) is designed for new chiefs and department administrators plus senior officers and supervisors who are preparing themselves for chief or other upper level police administrative positions. KPAS provides instruction in the "basics" of managing a department and its employees, with real world problems and decision-making that a chief of police confronts daily. The subjects discussed are not the usual law enforcement subjects. As a chief or administrator of a police department ... *you use everything you know* to do your job. KPAS is designed to add to that experience and knowledge base to help you do your job better.



### *Application*

Applicants should be a chief of police or member of a police department's command staff responsible for administrative level policy/decision-making. In addition to a completed application, applicants must submit a one-page, typed resume describing their work experience, educational background, law enforcement training background, reason for applying for this seminar, and their future career plans in law enforcement. Class size is limited to 24. If the number of applicants exceeds 24, applicants will be selected based on criteria developed by the KACP Training Committee.

**Please do not send any money with your application. You will receive confirmation of your reservation in this seminar by mail. Then your \$200 registration fee will be due to the KACP by The beginning of class. Meals at KLETC, room accommodations, and training expenses are underwritten by KACP and KLETC.**

All other expenses are the responsibility of attendees. Attendees must stay on the KLETC campus due to the intensity of the training. Successful applicants should be prepared for extended evening sessions and after-hours homework assignments.
